MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Works with Family & Community Partnership Specialist to fulfill recruitment, enrollment, and attendance requirements
- Facilitates & tracks children's physicals, lab work, dental exams & treatment
- Maintains all documentation in children's files
- Provides case management & crisis intervention for families
- Guides families in setting and achieving personal goals
- Helps to initiate and sustain parent engagement
- Links families to community resources
- Works as a team member with classroom, site, and leadership team in case management
- Makes home visits to families and provides transportation when needed
- Compiles reports & statistics to FCP/ERSEA Specialist for required program monitoring
