Autumn is here and things sure cooled down quickly. Before you know it, we will be in our busy holiday season. Last week, Jackie and I had the opportunity to travel to Buffalo to receive an award from the Highmark Blue Fund which will support a new program called Food Rx: Stone Soup Success. Our plan for this project is to improve health outcomes in Orleans county by increasing access to healthy food but also by ensuring people have the tools and knowledge to prepare tasty meals with the food that is available. We are partnering with Cornell Cooperative Extension of Orleans in this effort and give special thanks to Matt Holland of The United Way of Orleans County for assisting us in writing the grant. In the story "Stone Soup" a delicious soup emerged as different ingredients were found even though in the beginning of the story all that was available was a stone, a pot, and some water. Ingredients came about through generosity and eventually something wonderful came about when at first, they thought they had nothing. We currently offer "Pop Up" pantry food distributions but sometimes find that people don't know how to prepare some of the ingredients. Other times they may not have the tools and utensils to prepare a meal. This program will arm people with the tools, the knowledge, and the access to healthy and nutritious ingredients and at the same time benefit our local farmers and our community. Prescriptions for healthy food items will encourage people to make healthy choices and our hope is this will contribute to healthier people with better health outcomes.
